

# **Happy Anniversary!**

Your church is due to celebrate a special milestone this year.

Make the most of it! Involve your community!

Here is a resource checklist from Word&Way, serving Midwest Baptists in print and electronically.

### Establish a timeline.

Are you having an event? Have you set a date?

Do you need to: Find historical materials? Locate former members? Invite special guests and former ministers? Request a proclamation? Advertise? Publish a history?

This process determines who is responsible for each task and when assignments need to be accomplished.

# Gather your materials.

Consider the history your church has established. Newspaper articles, church minutes, pictures, programs and those that have been members are just some of the resources you may already have on hand — or need to gather.

Is it organized? What may be at your city hall, public library or in the hands of current and former members?

# Publicize your event.

Who needs to know about this event? Are they local or scattered? Do you need a press release for local media? Utilize social media!

#### Involve others.

Share the fun! Use your event as an outreach event. Consider a church anniversary banquet, concert and similar activities to which you can invite the public. Create an initiative which can also meet a community need.

## **Keep publicizing!**

Once the event is over, use the opportunity to promote the church's milestone and thank those that were involved, members and non-members alike. Look for the "hook" that makes the story interesting and newsworthy, such as an event-related ministry outreach, charter members, a special reunion or a promotional contest in order to get your news published or broadcast.
